CERTIFICATE III IN CHRISTIAN MINISTRY & THEOLOGY

COURSE OVERVIEW

The Certificate III in Christian Ministry and Theology* is a nationally recognised vocational qualification which contributes to SACE and ATAR. Veta Youth delivers this qualification as Veta Morphus.

It provides an opportunity for students to be part of a Christian discipleship experience with a focus on building your faith, serving your community and spending time with like-minded peers.

OUTCOMES

This certificate is designed for students who are wishing to explore and develop their Christian faith in a practical, hands-on way. It includes retreats, which are held over three weekends throughout the year which are a compulsory part of this certificate.

This certificate provides a range of knowledge, skills and competencies that will enable a person to serve effectively in churches, parishes, para-church organisations, missionary organisations and schools.

COURSE COMPONENTS

The course is competency-based training and is designed to provide students with appropriate knowledge and skills in Christian Ministry and Theology. The course includes participation in:

COURSE DESCRIPTION

To work in childcare, you must have or be actively working towards at least a Certificate III qualification. This qualification reflects the role of workers in a range of early childhood education settings who work within the requirements of the Education and Care Services National Regulations and the National Quality Standard. They support the implementation of an approved learning framework, and support children's well-being, learning and development.

Depending on the setting, educators may work under direct supervision or autonomously. Under the Education and Care Service National Law (2011) the Australian Children's Education and Care Quality Authority (ACECQA) publishes lists of qualifications and information regarding regulatory requirements at www.acecqa.gov.au

Students that successfully complete the full Certificate III in Individual Support (Ageing or Disability) obtain transferable skills for pathways into the Health Sector.

ANMEC has partnered with leading industry providers, and training delivered uses evidence-based practice to support the principles of a person-centred approach and engage learners to deliver care that place the person at the centre of service with inclusive decision-making and informed choices about daily activities.
