

The [Australian Privacy Principles \(APPs\)](#) require the College to notify individuals of the following matters when collecting personal information from them:

1. In applying to volunteer at Portside Christian College (the College), you will be providing the College with personal information.
2. We will collect the personal information you provide us (for example, the information in this form and any supporting documentation) in order to assess your application and to support you as you volunteer. We may also make notes and prepare a confidential report in respect of your application.
3. The College has a policy of conducting volunteer screening checks (e.g. personal references, working with children checks) which will require us to collect personal information about you from others.
4. If you provide us with the personal information of others (e.g. referees, emergency contacts), we encourage you to inform them that you are disclosing that information to the College and why.
5. If you do not provide all the information requested you will not be able to volunteer at the College.
6. We will not disclose this information to a third party without your consent unless we are otherwise permitted to under the law.
7. Your personal information will not be disclosed to any overseas recipients.
8. Information, photographs and/or videos that include volunteers participating in College activities may be published in College publications and on our website.
9. The College's *Privacy policy (College community)* on the College's website contains further information about the College's general information handling practices including:
 - How you may seek access to and correction of your personal information which the College has collected and holds.
 - How you can make a complaint about a breach of the APPs and how the complaint will be handled.

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
